

Instructions for Preparing the Abstract

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Abstract. This file serves as an illustration of how to prepare a \LaTeX file for an Abstractbook. For preparing abstract, you need only the style file `aplm07.sty`.

Style `aplm07.sty` is prepared in somewhat oldfashioned way. You may \LaTeX your document using either $\LaTeX 2\epsilon$ (in compatibility mode) or old \LaTeX 2.09.

Your abstract should not be longer then one page (author addresses excluded).

Please, follow the restrictions mentioned here:

- (1) You are not allowed to input any other style option.

- (3) Style file has predefined Croatian characters \mathring{d} (type `\dj` to obtain it) and \mathring{D} (type `\Dj`). Usage: for example, `\Dj ur\dj ica` gives Đurđica.
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
